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Louisiana Project Grants are administered jointly by the Louisiana Division of the Arts (LDOA) and nine Regionals Arts Councils across the state. This program provides a system for funding community-driven art projects that meet local needs utilizing/the arts and encourage artists to engage with their community in meaningful ways.

Projects must involve dance, design arts, folklife, literature, media, music, theatre, or visual arts for the purpose @performance, exhibit, presentation, series or workshop. NEW THIS CYCLE, CULINARY ARTS PROJECTS WILL BE ACCEPTED. Please refer to the definition in the grant guidelines linked just below.

Request amounts can range from \$2,500 to \$7,500. All funded activities should take place between October 1 and September 31.
